## SECTION 9. REGULATIONS FOR "R-3" SINGLE FAMILY RESIDENTIAL DISTRICT

- Subd. 1. Permitted Uses. The following are permitted uses in an "R-3" District:
  - A. All permitted uses allowed in the "R-1" District.
- Subd. 2. <u>Accessory Uses</u>. The following are permitted accessory uses in an "R-3" District.
  - A. All permitted accessory uses allowed in the "R-1" District.
- Subd. 3. <u>Conditional Uses</u>. The following are conditional uses in an "R-3" District; requires a Conditional Use Permit based upon procedures set forth in this Ordinance; and shall be reviewed on an annual basis. Such review shall occur prior to the 2<sup>nd</sup> Council meeting in June..
  - A. All conditional uses subject to the same conditions as allowed in the "R1" District and shall be reviewed on an annual basis.
- Subd. 4. <u>Lot Requirements and Setbacks.</u> The following minimum requirements shall be observed in an "R-3" District subject to additional requirements, exceptions and
  - A. Lot area: 7,250 square feet
  - B. Lot width: 50 feet at the front setback line
  - C. Setbacks:
    - 1. Front Yards: Not less than twenty-five (25) feet
    - 2. Side Yards:
      - a. Interior Lots: not less than ten (10) feet.
      - b. Corner Lots: not less than ten (10) feet on the interior side yard, nor less than twenty-five (25) feet on the side yards abutting a public right-of-way.
    - 3. Rear Yards: 25 feet

## Subd. 5. Building Regulations.

- A. Each single dwelling unit shall have a floor area, exclusive of porches, sun decks, garages, and basements, of not less than 800 square feet.
- B. Each single dwelling shall be provided with a minimum of one garage unit, but not to exceed an accessory building equal to four garage units 900 square feet.
- C. No structure shall exceed 35 feet in height above grade.

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
