

The Public Works Department is responsible for the day-to-day operation and maintenance of our community's infrastructure and plays a key role in long-range planning for future infrastructure needs.

Public Works duties include, but are not limited to:

- **Streets** - Repairs, preventative maintenance, snow plowing, roadside trimming to prevent sightline obstruction, street sweeping, street signage, street and signal light maintenance.
- **Parks and Trails** - Maintenance of the City's public open spaces including parks, the Nelson Lakeside Park beach, the Veterans Memorial, City trails, and sidewalks.
- **Water, Sanitary Sewer, and Storm Sewer Systems** - Maintenance of the City's water production, distribution, sanitary sewer collection, and stormwater systems; water meter reading and repairs when needed, fire hydrants and utility locates.
- **Forestry** - Answering resident questions about trees, and managing growth of trees and brush in City parks.
- **Garbage** - Removing refuse from City park property and other City-provided waste receptacles.
