**BUSINESS ITEMS**

**Continuing Discussion Regarding Police Protection Services Contract**

Administrator Post updated the Council that there had been no compromise items discussed between the Orono and Long Lake staffs since the February 24, 2010 letter on the subject was received from the City of Orono. With both cities wanting to reach contract resolution by a June 1, 2010 date, the Long Lake Council directed staff to prepare a backup plan. Orono representatives were assured that they would be invited to respond to any requests after June 1<sup>st</sup>. Former Mayor Olson engaged the Council in discussion on this topic by providing history of how the current agreement came into being and the attention within the community that public safety receives.

**Discussion of the C.E.L. Rebranding Proposal (venue moved to Council chambers)**

Administrator Post introduced Cindy Leines from the C.E.L. Public Relations firm and asked the Council if they had questions on this proposal since the March 16, 2010 Economic Development Authority (EDA) meeting. Much discussion ensued with the subject of managing expectations between all parties being prime among them.
