

Election filing for city offices opens July 31, 2012

The following municipal offices will be included on the November General Election ballot:

- **Mayor** - Two year term beginning January 2013
- **Council Members** - Two seats, four year terms beginning January 2013

To run for the Mayor or a Council Member seat, candidates must file in person at the office of the City Clerk located at Long Lake City Hall during regular business hours between July 31 and August 14, 2012 (office will be open until 5:00 pm on the last day of filing). The filing fee for all municipal office candidates is \$2.00, or petition in lieu of filing fee.

WHEN AND WHERE WILL ELECTIONS BE HELD?

On Primary and General Election days, voting hours are from 7:00 am to 8:00 pm. The voting location for all City of Long Lake residents is Long Lake City Hall, 450 Virginia Avenue. Working on election day? Don't forget ... Minnesota law allows voters to take time off work with pay to vote on State election days. The Minnesota State Primary Election will take place on Tuesday, August 14. The Minnesota State General Election (ballot includes city offices) will be held on Tuesday, November 6.

CSAH 112 TURNBACK PROJECT

County State Aid Highway (CSAH) 112, also known as West Wayzata Boulevard, is an important corridor within the County. This roadway supports local and regional economic development, and services Hennepin County commuters as well as local roadway users as they access area residences, businesses and schools. CSAH 112 is a four-mile long corridor within the cities of Long Lake and Orono that was previously Trunk Highway (TH) 12 prior to the construction of the TH 12 bypass by MnDOT. The "turnback" of the roadway's jurisdiction from MnDOT to Hennepin County allows the county, along with the cities of Long Lake and Orono, to evaluate the roadway and identify and plan potential improvements. The county has begun the conceptual and preliminary design for the project, which will be complete by the end of 2013.
