



**MINUTES
CITY COUNCIL WORK SESSION
June 18, 2013**

CALL TO ORDER

The work session meeting was called to order by Mayor Hultmann at 5:34 pm.

Present: Mayor: Tim Hultmann; Council: Kurt Kaminski, Tom Skjaret, Donny Chillstrom, and Liz Olson

APPROVE AGENDA

A motion was made by Chillstrom, seconded by Skjaret to approve the Agenda as presented. Ayes: all.

BUSINESS ITEMS

Daniels Street Truck Traffic Signage - Update

Post advised the Council that discussions with Public Works Director Wurzer indicate that the previous "no thru truck traffic" signage on Daniels Street between Virginia Avenue and Lake Street (previously County Road 146) were removed to allow for a haul route during MnDOT Hwy 12 Bypass construction and never replaced. After discussion, Council directed staff to replace the signage after completion of the 2013 Brimhall/Tamarack reconstruction project at appropriate locations.

Discuss Collaborative Services Study

Post shared that the City of Wayzata requests that the City of Long Lake have internal discussions regarding staffing and facility options and scenarios before they (Wayzata) may propose any contract for services offers for consideration.

MCWD Long Lake Creek Project Update

Houdek referenced her memo and project map that were included in the meeting packet. She indicated that they are planning on beginning Phase I of streambank stabilization near Wayzata Blvd this year and are trying to secure funding for the restoration of the former wastewater treatment pond as a 2014 Phase II project. Discussion included sizing of the Wayzata Blvd culvert and a possible future additional community amenity when Phase II is completed. Post mentioned to Houdek that Hennepin County was having a CSAH 112 Open House on July 11, 2013 and it may be beneficial for MCWD to be aware of future reconstruction plans in this area.

OTHER BUSINESS

Olson mentioned that perhaps a joint Planning Commission/City Council meeting would be helpful. Olson also pointed out that the City Code of Ordinances posted on the City's website were not current in that Ordinances adopted over the past several years were not reflected. Other councilmembers agreed that the information should be taken off the website if not current. Chillstrom indicated that "no trailer parking to corner" signs on Lake Street were confusing.

The meeting was adjourned by general consent at 6:35 pm.
