CALL TO ORDER

The work session meeting was called to order at 5:37 pm.

BUSINESS ITEMS

Discuss CSAH 112 Turnback Project Open Forum Feedback Received and Potential Project Plan Revisions

Mayor and Council members reviewed revised plans for trails through downtown Long Lake proposed as part of the CSAH 112 Turnback Project, labeled as Trail Option A and Trail Option B. Council members discussed the options and debated the impacts of trail improvements on available parking in downtown, to Nelson Lakeside Park, and to residents on affected streets. It was the consensus of the Council that Hennepin County Engineer Jim Grube and Mike Turner of SRF Consulting should be requested to appear at the first work session meeting in January 2014 to further discuss the trail options proposed, and to provide clarification on the differences between the options proposed.

Discuss 2014 City Appointments

Mayor and Council members reviewed the annual list of subcommittee and other position appointments to be made for 2014 in preparation for making said appointments during the following regular meeting.

OTHER BUSINESS

Letter to Rowing Club – Staff received direction from Council to request the City Attorney prepare a letter to the Long Lake Rowing Club reminding them of the expiration of their Interim Use Permit for the use of the former Billy's Lighthouse site.

Joint Meeting with Orono – Mayor and Council discussed the need for meeting jointly again with the Orono City Council to further discuss establishment of a “no wake ordinance” for Long Lake, with a MnDNR representative present to provide clarification on high water levels and present information regarding shoreline restoration improvements/opportunities.
