CALL TO ORDER

The work session meeting was called to order at 5:32 pm.

BUSINESS ITEMS

Follow-up Review of Investments with Jack Fay, Ehlers Investments

Fay presented findings he was asked to do by the council related to rates of local banks. The finding showed favorable rates better or comparable to banks. It was recommended to divid up the funds that currently came do from past CDs into CDs at the banks with the best rates. The length of time will be shorter as the rates are really low and don't want to miss opportunities if rates change in the next 1-3 years.

Interview Park Board Applicant – Marc Crawford

Council interviewed Crawford were pleased with his background. He has been in the area for 8 years and wants to help the community. He wants to give back time to his community and feels by being on the park board improving trails and parks will do that. Council knows it is hard to find willing volunteers and with the upcoming projects it will be good to have Crawford on the board.

Update from Wayzata Police Chief Risvold and Discussion of Wayzata Crime Prevention Coalition Board

Risvold presented the call numbers from 2014. Some categories of crimes have went up and others have went down. The call numbers were slightly lower from 2013 overall.

Risvold updated the council on the speed sign. He suggests it gets moved farther down to a straight site line and will be working on getting that done.

Crime Prevention Coalition was created about 2 years ago and Long Lake was asked if they wanted a council member to be a representative.
