BUSINESS ITEMS

Continue Discussion of Water Meter Findings

Public Works Director Wurzer presented bench test findings of 3 possible water meters that could be approved for the City of Long Lake. The results indicated the meters record less than the manufacture says but some record more than others. The results showed the Iperl meter records anywhere from 2-7% percent more water and should be looked at in deciding what to purchase in the future.

Discuss LMCC and Complete Survey Forms

Council agreed they will continue as of now having Paul Mahoney as the Long Lake rep and will discuss appointment at the first meeting in January.

Council filled out a survey for LMCC and the Administrator will send it on.

Discuss Metropolitan Council SAC Determination for Birch's on the Lake

Council discussed the large number of units Metropolitan Council estimated for Birch's on the Lake. 42 SAC units were estimated because there wasn't any history of any units on file. This is a large dollar amount and is a pass through for the City. Council explained to protect the city an escrow account should be established while everyone works on reducing the number SACS for the property.
