discussed how proceeds from Orono Lions Club events are spent on community programs and initiatives.

**10,000 Lakes Wake Surf Open** – Council member Carpenter reported he'd attended the recent 10,000 Lakes Wake Surf Open and commented favorably on the event's use of Nelson Lakeside Park. Having the course route through the center of the lake minimized the event's impact on public use, and he would encourage using the same route in future year's events. The event organizers made an effort not to obstruct usage of the public launch as directed.

**City Engineer Candidate Interviews** – Post provided an update on the status of City Engineer candidate interviews and indicated once the interviewing subcommittee has reached a consensus, the preferred firm will be invited to the September 4 City Council meeting for final interview and possible appointment.
