BUSINESS ITEMS

Review Proposed Contract for 2015 Assessment Services from Southwest Assessing

Last April, Southwest Assessing took over the City of Long Lake. Their contract ran 12 months (July 1-June 30) plus the months of May and June 2013.

The proposal is for assessing services for the City of Long Lake with the contract dates beginning July 1, 2014 to June 30, 2015. The proposed contract is for \$18,480.00 and is the same dollar amount as the agreement in 2013/2014 years minus the 2 extra months.

Discussion on Interim Use Permit Ordinance and Essential Services Ordinance

Addison Lewis from WSB presented questions on the Essential Services Ordinance and wanted guidance from the council. The old ordinance reads that the city has to go through the same permitting as an individual. Having to go through the planning commission to get permission to do things seemed unneeded and a different process should be looked at and the council agreed.

Staff wanted council to review the interim use permit and express their concerns. Some of the wording wasn't allowing it to work the way they expected it too and should be reviewed.

Council and staff introduced themselves to Davidson. Council asked about her desire to be on the park board and she is wanted to find the community connection and wants parks to be a direct part of the community. She is a professor of mechanical engineering at the U of M.
