BUSINESS ITEMS

Discuss Pavement Management Plan Strategy- City Engineer- WSB Chris LaBounty

The City's pavement management plan consists of pavement maintenance and improvement projects scheduled for the City in a five-year look ahead period. The plan is revised and amended by the City every three years. Last year the City completed a city-wide rating of pavements and LaBounty presented three possible alternatives on how to move forward with the program.

No changes are proposed to the pavement maintenance schedule which has been working adequately for the City in the past.

To keep the schedule a few things will need to be considered. The costs of the CSAH112 reconstruction for the City is still not totally final and won't be for a year or 2. In the short term different roads could be seal coated to keep with schedule on track even if for reclaims and skipped.

Council agrees the scheduled should be followed if possible but again watch for the costs. Long Lake doesn't have large reserves to be reconstructing roads all the time.
